Tenants to Homeowners provides homebuyer education and safe, affordable, and owner-occupied housing. Their programs target the Self-Sufficiency goal.

Being permanently disabled, Brad wanted to live close to work to reduce dependence on public transportation. He had a difficult time finding an affordable and accessible rental unit close to his workplace. When a condominium unit close to his office was advertised for sale, Brad became interested in home ownership but wasn't sure he could afford it. He visited Tenants to Homeowners and discovered that their Lawrence Community Housing Trust homebuyer program would not only make it possible for him to purchase the condo but to rehab the unit as well. When asked about his home buying experience Brad said "My experience with Tenants to Homeowners was easy. The staff worked with me throughout the process to ensure that my new place is completely accessible and allows me to continue living an independent life. Looking back, the thought of how much I am saving by owning, compared to renting, is unthinkable."
