Community Partner Success Story:

Trinity In-Home Care increases the accessibility of healthcare and cultivates financial stability for families, people with disabilities, and caregivers, targeting the Health and Self-Sufficiency goals of our community.



A teenage mom was overwhelmed with her new role as a mother of a 2 week old baby and her own ongoing health issues. Fortunately, Trinity In-Home Care and a network of resources came to her rescue. Douglas County Health Department had monitored the mother and baby's health issues and continued to monitor the situation. The Fairy Godmother funds covered the cost of some Trinity In-Home care during her initial recovery. Success By 6 identified educational and wellness resources for her and her baby and are helping her to sustain her housing situation. The young mother was able to qualify for a Medicaid supportive program for the developmentally disabled, so she is now able to have assistance provided to her and her baby 5 days a week through Trinity In-Home Care.

A donation of \$1 per week for a year provides 6 hours of childcare by a trustworthy Trinity staff member.
