- 4 nights of lodging in a hotel for a family of four driven out of their home because of a fire; certifies 5 people with low income to receive their First Aid certification; or provides Lifeguard training ... and a summer job!!! to one individual. - ***American Red Cross, Douglas County Chapter***
- Three hours of educational advocacy to help parents work with the school to develop better ways to help their child with a disability succeed; or two hours of intensive support from our Autism Specialist to aid a family with a child with autism; or help pay for a child with disabilities to attend summer camp. - ***The Arc of Douglas County***
- Provides one working family in our community on the verge of homelessness the opportunity to remain in their home, by providing emergency rental assistance for one month, helping to also keep their utilities on, their children in daycare and remain working. - ***Ballard Community Services***
- Provides the cost of intake processing for volunteers from initial screening, individual background checks and references, interviews, matching and training. - ***Big Brothers/Big Sisters of Douglas County***
- Provides for all Council services, programs and facilities for one Scout for one year. - ***Boy Scouts of America, Heart of America Council***
- 48 weeks of quality after school programming for one student from a low income family. 400 snacks for children in the after school programs. - ***Boys and Girls Club of Lawrence***
- Would provide 2 families of four enough assistance to keep their electricity on during the cold winter or hot summer months. - ***Catholic Charities of Northeast Kansas***
- Provides a StoryTote, a curriculum kit filled with books, language/literacy materials, and activity ideas around a theme. Totes can be checked out for a two week period and utilized in a child care program, enriching the early learning environment through access to age-appropriate resources and materials - ***Child Care Aware of NE & NC Kansas***
- Turkeys to feed 6 families during the holiday season. - ***Douglas County AIDS Project, Inc.***
- Provides one month of advocacy for an abused or neglected child. - ***Douglas County CASA***
- 10 days full time care for Preschool aged child, 180% FPL - ***Douglas County Child Development Association***
- Provides a cleaning and exam for 3 uninsured adults. - ***Douglas County Dental Clinic***
- Provides representation for a client who seeks either a protection from abuse order or a protection from stalking order. - ***Douglas County Legal Aid Society***

- Home visit and/or medication review by a licensed nurse OR Carelink service for 4 months OR 8 bath/personal care aide visits OR telemonitoring service (blood pressure, weight, etc.) for 2 months. - **Douglas County Visiting Nurses, Rehabilitation and Hospice Care**
- Provides a hotel room plus two meals for a survivor seeking safe shelter, a security system installed and locks changed for a survivor who does not feel safe at home; purchase of a bus ticket for a survivor to re-locate to another city; or 8 sets of replacement clothing after a hospital exam. - **GaDuGi SafeCenter**
- A year's worth of program opportunities for one Girl Scout that helps her build courage, confidence and character with a lasting sense of responsibility and accountability to her community -- local, national and global. - **Girl Scouts of NE Kansas & NW Missouri**
- Bereavement support resources for 10 families. Safety handouts for 150 area kids in our safety classes. "Life Support" t-shirts rewarding 12 volunteer counselors for providing 300 hours of service each. - **Headquarters Counseling Center**
- Provides two bottles of insulin for a diabetic patient. - **Health Care Access Clinic**
- Provides counseling for one family for 6 months - **Housing and Credit Counseling**
- Provides 3 counseling sessions, bus passes & lunch funds for a client's 1st 7 weeks in a new job through the "Back to Work" jobs counseling program. Or Provides one printer cartridge for our "Good Dog" dog treats packaging labels. - **Lawrence Community Shelter, Inc. (LCS)**
- A hot, nutritionally balanced meal delivered by a caring volunteer to one client 5 days a week, for one month -- AND -- provide not only food but companionship and peace of mind! - **Meals on Wheels**
- Provides assistance with a family's utility bills or helps them keep them in their housing for a month. Provides an underprivileged child a week of enriching summer camp experience. - **Salvation Army**
- Provides one parent 8 weeks of Nurturing Parenting® classes. - **Success By 6 Coalition of Douglas County**
